ORDER

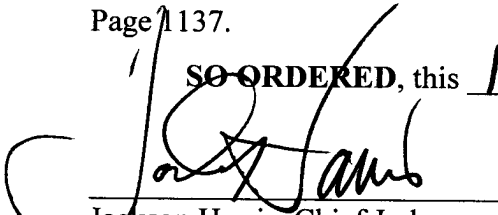
Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 19-1-1(b) and O.C.G.A. § 9-11-65(e), the Court hereby orders that the attached "Domestic Standing Orders" shall apply upon filing to all domestic relations actions as defined in O.C.G.A. § 19-1-1(a). The Clerk of Court shall cause the orders to be completed, by inserting the names of the parties and the case number, and to be filed with the case. This implementing Order including attachments hereby adopts and makes the Order of this Court the attached two Domestic Standing Orders which shall become separate orders when filed in each case and shall serve as notice of this entire order.

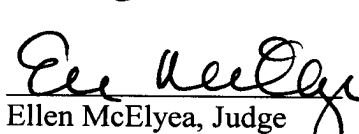
Upon the filing of domestic relations actions requiring *service by sheriff* or that are to be *served by publication*, the clerk shall attach copies of the filed standing order to the original and service copies of the action and give or mail a copy of the filed standing order to the attorney or person filing the action.

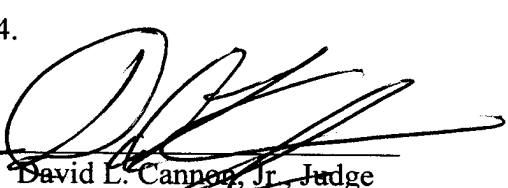
When domestic relations actions are filed with an *acknowledgment of service*, the clerk will attach a copy of the filed standing order to the original complaint and give or mail two copies of the filed standing order to the attorney or person filing the action, with instructions that he or she is responsible for serving the defendant with a copy of the order. The form for the Domestic Relations Pre-trial Order used in contested cases is attached.

This Order supersedes that Order filed January 14, 2013, and recorded in Minute Book 197, Page 1137.
